

Self Test For Fire Prevention

Home safety, good housekeeping and fire prevention go hand in hand.

Good housekeeping gets rid of trash and rubbish which causes at least 50,000 fires in American homes each year, according to the National Fire Protection Association.

Test yourself on the following questions. Each "no" answer is a signal for action to increase safety in your home.

1. Do you keep attic, basement and closets free of old clothing, curtains, drapes, mattresses, magazines and newspapers.

2. Do you dispose of trash and rubbish regularly by burning in a galvanized steel rubbish burner?

3. Do you empty ashtrays only when contents are completely cold or into fire safe covered metal cans? Are ashtrays large and deep enough to keep cigarettes from falling out?

4. Do you have heating equipment and chimney checked and cleaned at least once a year?

5. Are paints, solvents and thinners stored in tightly closed metal containers away from heat?

6. Are flammable liquids such as gasoline and kerosene kept out-of-doors in galvanized steel containers with tight-fitting caps and pouring spouts?

Awards Committee Named

An awards committee of four members has been appointed by Governor Grant Sawyer to screen state nominees for the national Young American Medals and to select Nevada award winners for bravery and service.

The governor's awards for this year have been designated as the "Mike Ingersoll Medals" in honor of the late University of Nevada student body president who was killed while making a parachute jump last December.

NAMED TO the Nevada awards committee are: Rulon A. Earl, Las Vegas, Chairman; Margaret Simmons, North Las Vegas; Abraham Feroah, Reno; and Robert (Buddy) Sampson, McGill.

The "Mike Ingersoll Medals" are patterned after the Young American Awards for Bravery and Service given annually by the Department of Justice. The national winners are selected from nominees made by the 50 state governors.

Governor Sawyer explained, however, that the state nominees have received very little recognition. The two national winners are announced in Washington, but usually very little is reported or done for those Nevadans whose heroism and devotion to others deserve the widest recognition.

"I want to give public recognition personally to those young people who are nominated for the national awards from Nevada", Governor Sawyer said.
