## Another Honor For Hero

WYANDANCH, L.I. - (NPI) -- This predominantly Negro community has named its new elementary school after an 18-year-old para-trooper from Chicago who received the Congressional Medal of Honor posthumously for his valor in Viet Nam.

LOS ANGELES - (NPI) -- Several members of the Sons of Watts--a group of former gang members who have gone straight--went on the radio in an appeal for racial calm. The teenagers, who conceded their participation in the Watts riots, have changed their tune.

INSTEAD OF tearing up the area, they have painted and placed trash containers throughout the Watts area and have set up a security patrol to guard business property for some local merchants. They also are setting up traffic signs in Watts housing projects, and are planning a self-help training course in upholstering and furniture repair.

The group, made up of 130 youths, is organized as the Sons of Watts Improvement association with headquarters in an abandoned gasoline

station.




