
OPERATION CAR WASH & STAMP DRIVE

Rather Bias Than Status

NEW ORLEANS--(NPI)--George Soule, white, has sent in his resignation from the City Planning commission stating that he did so as a result of the appointment of Dr. Albert W. Dent, President, Dillard university, to membership.

Dr. Dent, an international figure and member of some of the top commissions of the nation and of the world, was appointed a member by Mayor Schiro. Soule, unknown except in New Orleans, says he will not serve on a board with a Negro, even with a man as highly respected and as widely active as Dent.

The Mayor has appointed Negroes on other boards and no objections have been raised by members who recognized the Negroes appointed as top citizens of the community.







Negro World Bank Exec

WASHINGTON--(NPI)--Dr. Emmett J. Rice, 46, has been named U. S. alternate-executive director of the World Bank.

Dr. Rice, who formerly served as Acting Director, Office of Developing Nations in the Office of the Assistant Secretary for International Affairs in the Treasury Department, is the third Negro to be named by President Johnson to a top financial post.

President Johnson made the appointment upon the recommendation of Treasury Secretary Henry Fowler.

From 1962 to 1964, Dr. Rice worked as research advisor to the Central Bank of Nigeria, where he supervised 36 members and advised the governors of the bank on monetary and financial policy. From 1960 to 1962, he served as an economist with the Federal Reserve Bank of New York, specializing in money market analysis. He has been Assistant Professor of Economics at Cornell university.

President Johnson appointed two other Negroes to top financial positions before Dr. Rice.
They are Hobert Taylor, Jr., director, Export-Import Bank, and Andrew J. Brimmer, governor, Federal Reserve Board.
