## Tall Tale From Vietnam

SOMEWHERE IN VIETNAM--(NPI)--The story of how a Marine's height, not only saved his life, but also the lives of his patrol in making the rounds in the jungle area of Vietnam.

The story is told by Lance Cpl. McKinley Askew of Chicago--who stands 6 feet 8 inches--that at least on one occasion his height saved his life and that of his squads.

"We were on a patrol in the Phu Loc area," he said, "and we didn't realize it at the time, but we got turned around in the tall grass and were headed in the wrong direction crossing into another patrol's ambush site. The first we knew of the danger was when a Marine yelled, 'he's too tall for a Viet Cong, hold your fire'."

A member of the 2nd Battalion 1st Marine Regiment, 1st Marine Division, the Marine Lance corporal has already laid claim to the title of tallest Marine in the Republic of Vietnam. A radio operator, Askew says, "I think I'm the tallest Marine in Vietnam, but, to be on the safe side I'll settle for the title of the tallest radio operator in the country."
