NEW ORLEANS--(NPI)--The last stand of those who wish to retain racial segregation and grants-in-aid for schools seems to be seen in Plaquemines parish, often referred to as "Perez Country."

The public schools have been ordered to remain open and to operate despite boycott by white parents and teachers. Courts insist upon the continuation of public schools and whites insist upon segregation.

A school in Belle Chase, where over 2,000 pupils once attended, now has only 72 whites and 30 Negroes. It has only three teachers. The principal says the Catholic diocese has offered to furnish nuns to teach the children. No acceptance of this offer has been made public. Many Negro teachers say they are qualified and would gladly teach in the schools. Of course no acceptance of this offer.

The courts are now considering the constitutionality of the grant-in-aid policy which gives a child \$2 a day of public money enabling the child to escape integration. It is thought that this may well end racial segregation in the state of Louisiana as the people are unable to properly support two school systems--one from public and the other from private funds. The public schools have been in hot financial water existing alone without extra weight.

vote, was defeated in his write-in campaign for U. S. Governor. Sabonjian has blamed the NAACP for racial outbreaks in his city and called demonstrators "winos" and "animals."

Winner of the election was Charles Percy, a Republican, who fought a bitter duel with Democrat Paul. H. Douglas over who was more two-faced on civil rights. Percy's relatively weaker stand on open housing--an emotionally charged issue, especially in the wake of recent open occupancy marches in all-white areas of Chicago --was said to have been the "trick that clicked" for him.
