#### MORE NEGRO MAYORS?

SEATTLE, Wash. - (NPI) -- Three Northern cities with large Negro populations will have Negro mayors by 1970, Rep. John Conyers, Jr.,

(D.-Mich), has predicted.

"By 1970," he said, "we can expect to double the number of Negro congressmen and have mayors in Newark, Baltimore, Cleveland and

The 90th Congress will have six Negro

representatives and one senator.

Some 150 Negro candidates were elected last Nov. 8, almost doubling the number of Negro office holders. "Population trends and the Voting Rights Bill do herald a time when American politics and government can be really representative of the American electorate," he

be presented to the School Board of Trustees for final approval tonight (Thursday). The Board is said to strongly disapprove of busing students.

If the action policy meets with Board approval, the first stage of the multi-action plan would begin immediately (January 1) and continue through the 1969-70 school year, the target date projected for completion of integration

STAGE ONE of the plan would include the initiation of an encompassing compensatory education program including remedial reading, equal education opportunities and Project Head Start. Emphasis will also be placed on more equitable teacher employment and placement without regard to race, color, or creed; a realistic curriculum with textbooks depicting the role of minority groups in America's history

and their contributions to the nation's heritage. Other action plans of Stage One include indepth Counseling programs, and reorganization of attendance areas to bring about integration.

The matter of careful attention to selection of future school sites to remedy the evil of de-facto segregation is included in the Stage Two plan scheduled to end during the 1974-75 school
