## RECORD TAX LIEN AGAINST NEGROES FILED

NEW ORLEANS - (NPI) - What is considered the biggest legal action by the government for collection of taxes against Negroes was started last week when federal tax liens of over \$700,-000 were filed against three Negroes charged with possession of over \$1,000,000 worth of narcotics and not paying income tax on this amount. No charges of income tax evasion have been filed as the taxes are not due until April 15.

The government agent said this large amount represented what the trio owed on their 1966 earnings on drugs. The trio and the amount of

the liens were as follows: LEROY SMITH--\$370,713.89, MELVIN SMITH--\$172,289.79, MARGERET SMITH--\$167,534.45.

They were arrested following a raid on their residence located in what was once the most highly respected area in New Orleans where the cream of white society was wont to live in olden days. The raid was made on a Sunday but since state law bars raids on Sabbath, illegal charges of possession were dropped. Also found in the house during the raid was approximately \$200,000 in cash.
