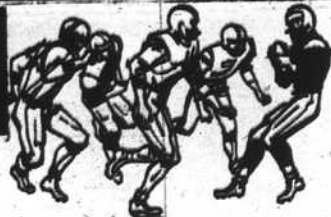

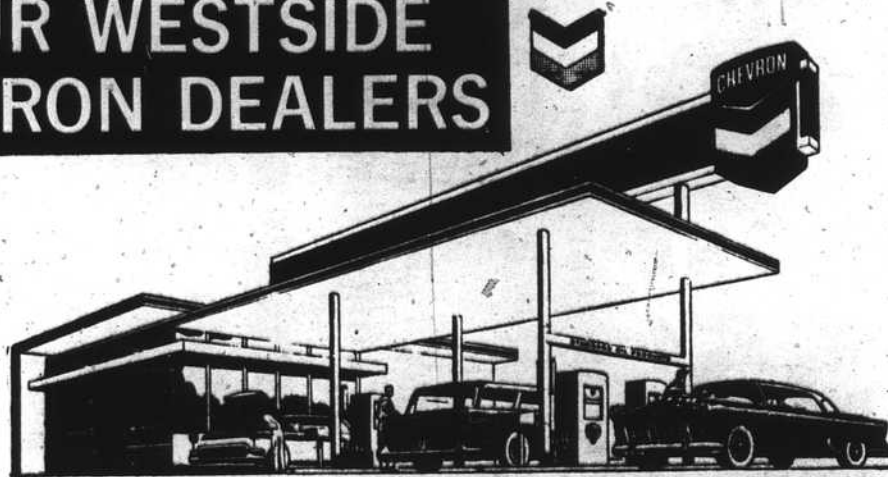

Boxing Hall Of Fame For Archie Moore - Gavilan

NEW YORK - (NPI)--Kid Gavilan, ex-welterweight boxing champion, and Archie Moore, former light-heavyweight champion, have been elected to the Boxing Hall of Fame. Moore won his title in 1952, when he whipped Joey Maxim. He retired in 1956, when he was in his early 40s. Gavilan, now 40, won his title in 1951 by defeating Johnny Bratton and Billy Graham in elimination bouts. He now lives in Cuba.
