WASHINGTON - (NPI)--Half of the nation's non-whites are poor, according to a study of "The Poor In City and Suburbs, 1964," which appeared in the Social Security Bulletin.

A Negro is three times more likely to be poor than a white man, the study indicated. Only a seventh--or about 17 per cent--of whites are poor, compared to about 50 percent of Negroes.

THE STUDY set the poverty line approximately where the Office of Economic Opportunity sets it: slightly more than \$3,000 a year income for a family of four. Half the nation's poor families--and seven

Half the nation's poor families--and seven out of 10 of the Negro poor families--live in the South, the study holds. Whites outnumber Negroes among the big-city poor, although attention has been focused on Negro poverty, it was noted.

NEARLY HALF the nation's 34 million poor live in big cities or their suburbs, the report, written by Mollie Orshansky, an employee of the Social Security Administration's office of research and statistics, declared.

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
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League Women Offer Legislative News Letter
