### Solon Urges Negro Political Involvement

CHICAGO - (NPI)--Rep. John Conyers, Jr. (D-Mich.) has warned Negro Americans against staying away from the polls in a "silent protest vote against a racist and discriminatory society."

"That form of protest is so silent that no one ever hears it," he said. "The only way Negro Americans can change the system is to enter political life and make our presence felt," he said. "We must organize and educate ourselves for effective political action, he added. "Negro Americans must register and vote effectively in every election. Only if we use our political rights fully will we gain economic and social freedom."

"WHILE OUR brothers in the South risk their lives for the right to vote, surely we in the North can bestir ourselves to register and vote when we don't have to face those dangers. Though obstacles are surely placed in our way, we cannot claim we have Sheriff Jim Clarks or mobs to face."

Conyers stressed the importance of Negroes voting in local elections since "city government directly handles those programs which have special and immediate effect on Negro Americans."

"We cannot possibly get from our elected officials the kinds of programs leading to better education, housing, and welfare programs if we don't show up on election day and vote for those who support those programs. To get our civil rights, we must fulfill our civil responsibilities."

Rep. Conyers spoke at a kick-off voter registration rally at Liberty Baptist church, sponsored by the Chicago Freedom Movement. A month-long drive is aimed at registering tens of thousands of new Negro votes to participate in the February and April elections for the city council and the mayor.

The effort is co-sponsored by Dr. Martin Luther King's Southern Christian Leadership Conference and the Coordinating Council of Community Organizations.
