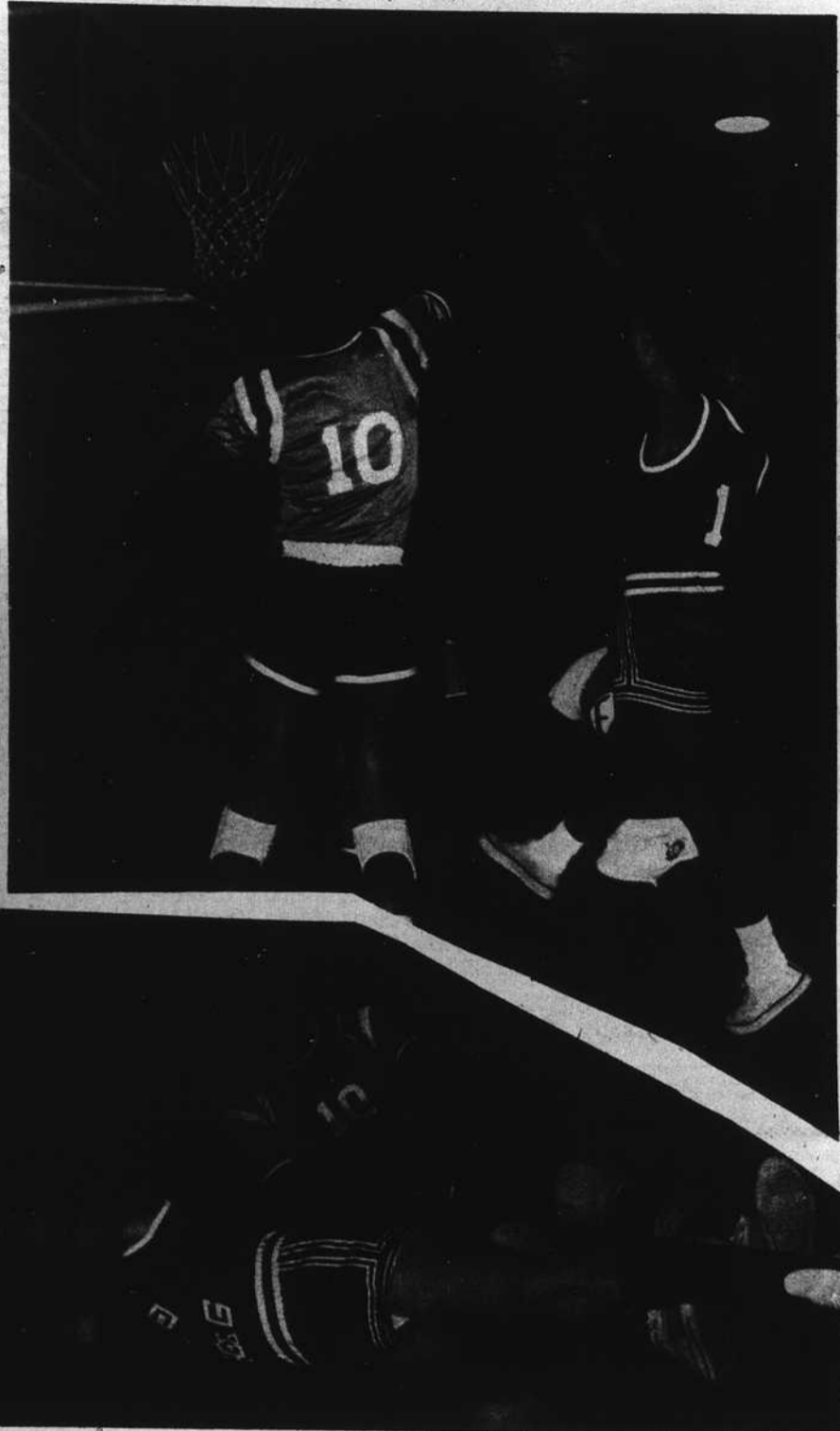
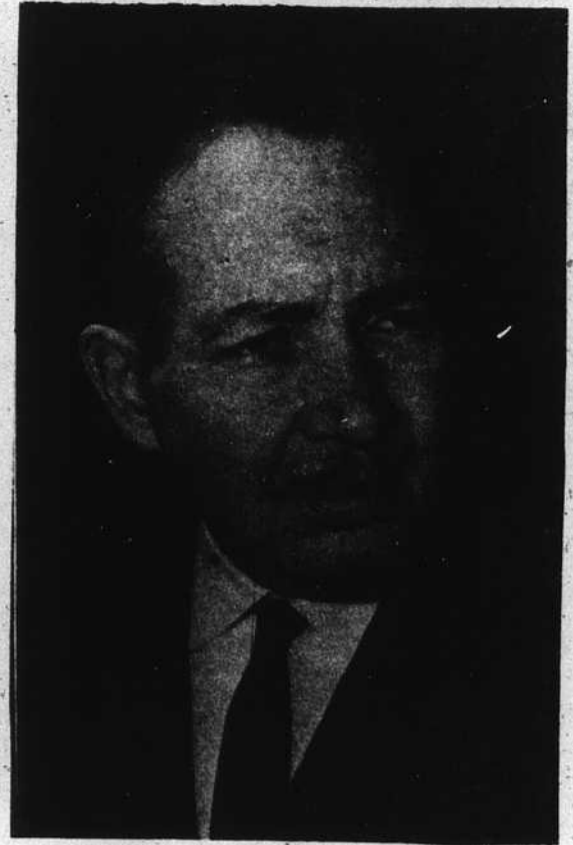


UPS AND DOWNS On The Basketball Court
