Matt Kelly Principal Addresses AAHPER Group

JOHN WALKER, Principal Matt Kelly Elementary School, appeared as a program speaker at the American Association for Health, Physical Education and Recreation's 82nd Anniversary National Convention held at Convention Center here March 10-14. Theme of the Convention "Education Is Our Business" was hailed by President Lyndon B. Johnson as "one that underlies the objective of all who have a share in the guidance of our nation's youth".

The Westside school principal's address entitled "Municipal Recreation and the Schools" was presented Saturday afternoon (March 11) during the Recreation Division's session presented by the organization's Recreation Services Commission in Room 2, Convention Center with Commission Chairman Joseph B. Wargo, Public School, Flint, Michigan, presiding.

STRESSING THE importance of a varied program of activities as providing sufficient interest to keep many youngsters in school, the educator pointed out that "there should be optimum cooperation and coordination between (not only city and school personnel), but also between the use of city and school facilities".

As point of example, Walker detailed the "joint use agreement" and cooperation existent here in Las Vegas between the Doolittle Center (a municipal recreation facility) and local schools.

"Joint use" advantages was exemplified by Principal Walker in listing following cooperative programs of the Matt Kelly School and Doolittle Recreation Center.

1. During the regular school day our physical education programs occasionally use the gymnasium.
2. Flyers (notices) and announcements concerning activities at the Doolittle Center are sent home with the Matt Kelly School children. (Girl Scouts, Brownies, basketball, pre-school and field day).
3. Our school provides teachers to coach the

- teams in boys' 5th and 6th grade football and basketball. One of our women teachers coaches the girls' basketball team.
