

BOY SCOUT TV SHOW

A half hour television Special on activities of the Boulder Dam Area Council Boy Scouts of America will be aired simultaneously on all three Las Vegas channels Saturday, March 25 at 10 a.m. The T.V. Special, according to Jack Biegger, General Manager of Fletcher Jones Chevrolet will serve as official kickoff of the ticket sales campaign for the 1967 Scout Fun Fair which will be held at Convention Center on April 22. Biegger is ticket Chairman.

THE 30 MINUTE show will tell the Fun Fair story to the viewing public and highlight Scout activities and exhibits to be displayed at the Fair. The show will also introduce Showman Sam, symbol of this year's Fun Fair. Of special interest to Scouts will be a segment on ticket selling do's and don'ts and an exhibit of prizes which can be won by outstanding Scout-salesmen.

The Special was filmed at the newly-opened Boulder Dam Area Council headquarters on Maryland Parkway. The Council, under the direction of Scout Executive John Dupree, is comprised of eight districts (Mohave, Lake Mead, Paradise, Colorado River, Red Rock, Sunrise, Valleys and Cathedral Gorge) and directs Boy Scout activities of more than 9,000 members.

As of March 25, tickets (\$1.00) will be available for the '67 Fun Fair from all Boy Scouts. 60% of the 30,000 ticket sale expectation, said Biegger, will be returned directly to the Scouts and Units in the form of commissions and prizes.

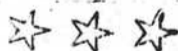

Navy Late To Integrate

SAIGON - (NPI)--The U.S. navy does not appear to be following the army's example of integration.

While a racially united army devoted its efforts to fighting the Viet Cong, the navy seemed to be busier fighting among itself along racial lines. Only one per cent of the navy's officers are Negroes. The Negro sailors aboard ships like the aircraft carrier Enterprise, off North Vietnam, face a heritage of segregation and racial discrimination which the navy has not yet shaken.

NEGROES USED to be used only as messmen in the navy. They are allowed to do other kinds of work now, after being replaced by Filipinos. The Filipino messmen have segregated billeting and assignments just as Negro sailors-used to have.

Aboard the carrier Enterprise, racial brawls, social discrimination, and discriminatory ratings of Negro sailors have been reported. No Negro has ever risen above the rank of navy captain, although Comdr. Samuel L. Gravelly, Jr., a Negro who commands a destroyer, is said to be considered for a promotion.
