

Jo Mackey Choir Slated For NAACP Meet Sunday

The 98-voice chorus of the Jo Mackey Elementary School sixth grade department will present a musical program for the Las Vegas Chapter of the NAACP during the Chapter's April 9 meeting to be held at Doolittle Center starting at 3 p.m. this coming Sunday.

The Musical Group performed before more than 8,000 children and adults during the 1965-66 school year and has been invited to sing for the Utah State Education Association in Cedar City this Spring according to school officials.

The Group is trained and conducted by Herschel Williams and Shirley Collins, sixth grade teachers at the school and accompanied by Bobbie Jean Smith, also a teacher at Jo Mackey School.

Negro Elected President Of All-White Bank

CHICAGO - (NPI)--Norman A. Simon has become the first Negro banker in the nation to head a formerly all-white bank.

Simon, a former officer of the Exchange National Bank, was elected president of Guaranty Bank and Trust Company.

THE FIRST Negro to be graduated with a degree in Commerce from Roosevelt University, Simon also was the first non-white officer in a Chicago Loop Bank.

A native of New Orleans, he served from 1941 to 1945 as technical sergeant in the U.S. Army. He worked toward his bachelor's degree in Commerce while being employed at nights by Mammouth Life Insurance Company.

SS Beneficiaries Who Must File Tax Return

ALL PERSONS entitled to social security checks in 1966 and who were under age 72 any part of 1966 must file an annual report with social security if earnings exceeded \$1500 in 1966.

If you are required to file an annual report, you should do so as soon as possible. THE DEADLINE, UNDER LAW, FOR FILING IS APRIL 15, 1967. If you wait until after April 15, you may lose extra social security payments.

Your social security office will be glad to help you with any questions you may have. You may phone or write them, or you may wish to visit them if you have a special problem. If you visit the office after receiving your Form W-2 from your employer or after completing your income tax return, please take a copy with you. However, if you mail in your annual report, please do not enclose your Form W-2 or tax return.

If you have already sent us your annual report for 1966, please do not send another unless there is a change in what you reported.

Protests War Protests

NEW YORK - (NPI)--NAACP Executive Director Roy Wilkins has taken issue with efforts to drag the Vietnam war into the civil rights issue.

"Civil rights battles," he said, "are going to have to be fought and won on their own merits, irrespective of the state of war and peace in the world."

Wilkins made the remark as he was presented the 1967 Freedom Award by Freedom House "for outstanding contributions to the cause of human liberty."

The NAACP executive director disagreed with "extremists," whose pain "drives them to positions that are, in reality, illusory." While civil rights matters cannot be "altered overnight," change must "come more swiftly than it has in the past," he said.

Disagreeing with efforts to link the Vietnam and civil rights issues, Wilkins was the only major national rights leader not planning to participate in antiwar protests set for April 15.
