

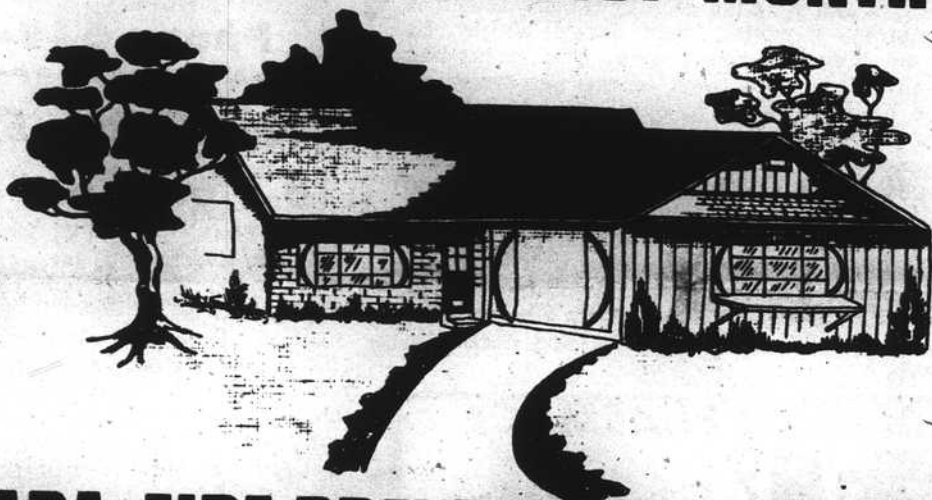
**REECO TREATS YOUNGSTERS TO JAYCEE CIRCUS**
