It is not too late for each and every one of us to make him or herself responsible to see that everyone who can vote, does. Neither is it too soon to start a registration drive for all future elections.

IT CAN happen--and it must happen. As this was written, during three interruptions, three individuals volunteered to become deputy registrars. That's all we need. Concern - Commitment - and Concentrated effort toward achievement of our needs, goals, and desires. All of it is possible through the ballot. Make voting a commandment to ourselves and to all those around us.

This is a game everybody can play on equal terms. It is vitally important to remember that chiefs are not needed nor wanted--only a multitude of braves if this nation, this state, this city is ever to become truly the "land of the free and the home of the brave". And to labor a point, need it be pointed out who needs what the most in this land?

returned to the cell where I spent the rest of the night. After the booking, at 7 a.m. May 7, I was told I could make two calls, of which I still got no answers.

At about 12:45 p.m. May 7, I made contact with the church, the representatives were sent, bail was posted, and at approximately 3 p.m. I was released in the custody of Elder Rex Ming and associate ministers.

Court hearing was set for 1 p.m. Monday May 8, at which I attended on time. Our case came up about 2:45 p.m. Judge Herman J. Fisher presided. We were asked if we understood the charges to which we replied, No. After giving the disposition of my circumstances, at the time of the arrest and listing the valuables I had in my possession, the case was dismissed.

The bail was \$25.75, which was handled by a local bonding company and no further redress was afforded me at the time, nor do I know of any recompense other than civil action thereto.
