N.Y. Negro Count Low Request Special Census

NEW YORK - (NPI)--A state senator from Harlem, who believes 300,000 New York Negroes were missed in the 1960 census, has urged Mayor John Lindsay to request a special federal census to find out how many Negroes really live in the city.

Sen. Basil A. Paterson wants the special census because he believes the city could be losing as much as \$2.5 million yearly in state aid due to uncounted Negro residents.

New York has the largest Negro population of any U.S. city. The 1960 census placed the total at 1,087,931, but the true number is estimated to be closer to 1.4 million.

Sen. Paterson believes the number of Negro residents was undercounted because of inefficiency and timidity among census takers--especially white ones.

He said a more accurate count would be obtained if only Negro census takers were used in non-white areas.
