## Demo Mayoral Candidate Faces United Opposition

BOSTON - (NPI) -- Mrs. Louise Day Hicks, candidate for mayor, is being opposed by a united Negro community which can't stand her 'sly racist' tactics.

Mrs. Hicks is known as "the Fat Lady" who opposes school busing to promote integration. Some say she's against school desegregation

SHE GOT her reputation as a supporter of the "neighborhood school" concept while she was chairman of the five-man elective committee, which corresponds to the school board in other communities.

Seeking to become the city's first woman mayor, Mrs. Hicks has only to tell Irishmen and other whites in this city, "You know where I stand," and she wins instant support.

As Negroes are a small minority in this city, she doesn't have to worry about losing a lot of votes with statements such as these: believe that little children should go to school in their own neighborhoods. It's as simple as

At other times, she has charged that rioters were coddled during the June disturbances.

'If I am mayor, no police officer of this city will be sacrificed on the altar of civil disobedience," she said. On the other hand, she challenges "anyone to prove I've been anti-Negro either by word or action."

NEGRO leaders didn't need to "prove" anything against Mrs. Hicks. They simply condemned her campaign, also opposed by such top political leaders as Sen. Edward M. Kennedy (D.-Mass.) and Massachusetts Gov. John A.
