LOS ANGELES - (NPI)--"Black doors are closing to white idealists" in Negro areas, according to President Johnson's nephew, Philip Bobbitt, a volunteer in the Volunteers in Service to America (VISTA) program. He referred especially to his experience in working with poor people in Los Angeles' Venice district, where he said black people are "alienated and angry."
