Segregated Mardi Gras **Events Hit By Navy**

NEW ORLEANS - (NPI) -- A Navy communication has described the Mardi Gras balls as segregated events. It stated many of the officers of ships visiting the Port of New Orleans for the Mardi Gras were invited to the different social functions being staged but that officers of Negro, Jewish and Italian descent were ig-

nored and by-passed.

Mayor Victor H. Schiro disclaimed city reonsibility for invitations to any Carnival events. The balls, and parties and those invited were the responsibility of private clubs and

New Orleans has been a racially discriminating city for years and Jews were not permitted to belong to the famous Boston Club, so they say. One person said the top club of the city, the New Orleans Country Club, only permitted Jews to join when the club was next door to insolvency for lack of people with sufficient funds to patronize the club.

No action pertaining to prohibiting the men to attend the socially and racially segregated parties and balls by the armed service has been

made public.
