Even Florida's Governor Shuns Wallace Campaign

SACRAMENTO - (NPI)--Third-party Presidential candidate George Wallace is receiving more rebuffs than support in his effort to "hurt both national parties."

While his American Independent Party has been placed on the California ballot, Ohio officials refused to put his name on the state's ballot, and he is likely to be excluded from the Wisconsin ballot.

Then Florida Gov. Claude R. Kirk, Jr., charged that Wallace's candidacy would be a major threat to a GOP Presidential victory in 1968.

Wallace's idea is to siphon off enough Democratic and Republican votes so that the Presidential election will be thrown into the House of Representatives.
