The youngsters had drawn on all their resources to offer aid to the Willis Jackson family who suffered the tragic loss of two little girls (ages 3 and 4) in the disastrous fire that burned the family out of its home at 509 Recco on February 7.

Under the supervision of Jo Mackey principal H. P. Fitzgerald, an adult committee was formed with Mrs. Overton Curtis serving as Chairman. Other committee members were Mesdames Wilbert Jackson, Robert Fortson, and George Johnson. These ladies organized the project to which the students responded so warmly and so sympathetically. The Jackson home was in the Jo Mackey School zone.

The children brought a total of \$82 in cash, 324 gans of food, 15 bars of soap, and 32 boxes of staples to be given to the bereaved family who are now at the home of Mrs. Jackson's mother at 1921 Walker Street. The grieving parents have two other children, a seven year old daughter, and a son, age 2-1/2.

Mr. Jackson, whose hand was severely burned in the fire, will require additional surgery on his hand before he can return to work.
