WASHINGTON - (NPI)--Dr. Martin Luther King, Jr., has been accused of practicing "brinksmanship" in planning his April 22 demonstrations.

The charge was made by Alfred Baker Lewis, NAACP national treasurer, who said Dr. King's march could be "a dangerous thing."

Lewis made the accusation at the same time that the local NAACP office backed the demonstration. This indicated a rift between the national and local NAACP organizations over the "Poor People's March," in which provocative violation of the law has been threatened.
