HOUSING BILL

CHICAGO - (NPI)--According to a preliminary report issued by the American Association of Medical colleges more Negroes will beentering medical schools this fall than have entered since 1963. The report, basing its conclusions on information supplied by 90 of medical schools, says some 300 Negro students will be starting their training this fall, a 50 per cent increase over the total of the past five years.

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
