magistrate presiding over Department 2. In this case the City of Las Vegas induced the Legislature to pass some special legislation which gives the Mayor the right to appoint whomever he wants in Department 2 and to pay him any salary. This person, according to this legislation, needs never stand before the electorate, or to be approved by anybody. He doesn't need to be approved by the Bar Association, the voters, or anyone else. No one has any jurisdiction over him. This kind of special privilege for persons who have the contact to achieve it results in lack of respect for law and order, and lack of efficient or effective administration. Presumably, the judge of Department 2 can hold office for life, without being accountable to anyone. It is very possible that the Municipal Court of the City of Las Vegas takes in more money than any criminal court of its size in the United States!

Why do the authorities of the City of Las Vegas insist upon this kind of special treatment? Perhaps their lack of respect for law and order is contagious. The common person in the street, who sees no respect for law and order coming from above, develops little on his part toward that law and order!
