House Approves King Observance

Springfield, Ill. - (NPI)--The House of Representatives has passed a bill to require public schools to honor the late Dr. Martin Luther King, Jr., on his birthday, Jan. 15, when that date falls on a school day.

Rep. Harold Washington of Chicago, a Black man, proposed the commemoration of Dr. King in the public schools, after being unable to obtain passage of a previous bill that would make Jan. 15, a school and legal holiday.

The bill requiring observance of Dr. King's birthday in the public schools is said to have a better chance of passage in the state Senate than a bill making Jan. 15, a holiday.
