For half a million young recipients of social security benefits the beginning of summer is a critical time. These are the students, between 18 and 22, who must notify the Social Security Administration of their intention to return to school in the fall if

up and sprayed him in the face. The spray he later learned was mace. Smith stated that he was blinded by the stuff and almost immediately was struck by a blackjack or nightstick about the face. One officer grabbed him from behind and the other officer clutched his left shoulder but mostly had hold of his shirt. He heard a door open as he was given a shove; he heard some voice say "why don't you guys leave the little guy alone."

He felt himself falling, but could not break his fall as his hands were still handcuffed behind his back. His chin hit the concrete causing him additional pain, besides the burning pain in his eyes.

How long he layed in the tank, he does not know. He only remembers being taken to a hospital. His legs were either held together by leg locks or handcuffs, he was not sure (because) he still was not able to see. He was "sewed up" and returned to the drunk tank. Early Saturday morning he was given food, but could not eat because two teeth were broken and the inside of his mouth was swollen and sore.

Smith stated that he asked to make a phone call but was refused, however when the day watch arrived he was allowed to call his employer.

One of the salesmen for the company was sent down to bail him out and posted a \$25.00 bail.

Smith says that he was released and was driven to his employers place of business, where he related to his boss of the events that occurred.

He returned Monday morning at 9:00 expecting a trial but was informed that a trial was not necessary as the bail would cover the fine.

Smith states that he is still unable to eat and that he needs medical assistance.

The oldest social security beneficiary, Charlie Smith, of Bartow, Florida, is 127 . . . and the youngest was born today!

Social security pays benefits to the children of deceased, disabled, and retired workers. Nearly 4 million children get social security checks each month.

Four generations of a Lynnwood, Washington, family are receiving social security benefits . . . and only 2 of them are retired.

Ethel Crary, 81, has been getting retirement benefits since she was 65—22 years—and her daughter, Ethel Ashby, 63, also receives retirement payments. Mrs. Ashby's daughter, Virginia Parker, gets social security disability benefits, and her young son and daughter receive payments as her dependents.

One out of four social security beneficiaries is under 65 and one out of eight is under 18.

Half the U.S. population is under 30 and approximately one-third is under 18. Nearly all are protected by social security.
