Pictured above is charming and most personable Mrs. Helen Anderson--an outstanding member of the Las Vegas Alumnae Chapter of Delta Sigma Theta Sorority who was recently appointed to serve on a National Committee by Deltas's National President, Attorney Frankie Freeman during their 28th Farwest Regional Conference which will be hosted by the local chapter at the Thunderbird Hotel from June 25 to June 28, 1970.

Soror Anderson is certainly symbolic of what Delta Sigma Theta Sorority stands for due to her dedication of service to the community and to humanity as a whole. She was initiated in Alpha Nu Chapter in 1945 and has been a Speech Therapist for fifteen years.

She is now principal of Kit Carson Elementary School and is Clark County School District's first female Black principal. Because of her long and untiring history of community work she received the NAACP's Annual Award as "Woman of the Year" 1966.

Her husband James Anderson is very active in Civil Rights Affairs and her only son Robert is a Senior Political Science Major at Bishop College in Dallas, Texas.

Her local sorors are quite proud of her many accomplishments and know that she will serve them well on the appointed committee on Delta. Properties during the conference.
