

### Harmon Files E.M. ("Al") Gunderson Files For Assembly For Nevada Supreme Court



George L. Harmon, a veteran Nevada legislator who previously served in four sessions as an Assemblyman from Clark County, filed Thursday as a candidate for the Assembly in District #4.

Expressing deep concern in the areas dealing with corporate gaming, reapportionment, education, and the plight of Nevada's senior citizens, Harmon pointed to his past legislative record and his knowledge and experience relative to the important issues facing us today as a prime asset for the voters' consideration.

E. M. ("Al") Gunderson, a prominent 41-year-old Nevada lawyer with offices in Las Vegas, announced this Thursday that he will be a candidate for the Nevada Supreme Court seat being vacated by Justice Jon Collins.

Discussing his candidacy, Gunderson said: "I have long intended and desired to undertake a career in the judiciary, and now I feel financially able to do so without undue hardship to my family. I am particularly attracted to the work done by our Supreme Court because it affords an opportunity for concentrated legal scholarship, and effective thought relating to the vital problems of our time."

Continuing, Gunderson said: "In undertaking to run for the seat being vacated by Justice Collins, I would feel remiss if I did not express regret that economic obligations to his family have impelled this exceptional Nevadan to leave the bench in the prime and height of his judicial career."

"However, since this is a fact, I believe it is essential that Justice Collins be succeeded by a man who is able to devote himself to the office with equal vigor; for in this day the bench is a career to which one should aspire



and dedicate himself, and not a place to retire. Justice Collins, who brought to the bench the full force of mature manhood, accomplished much during his tenure with the Court; but much remains to be done, as I know he would agree. I feel I have reached the point in life when I have the most to offer my State, its people, and what I consider my true vocation."

### Santini Files For JP

Las Vegas Township will get a full day's work for a full day's pay if he is elected Justice of the Peace, James Santini said today as he filed formal candidacy for the office.

"I am perfectly willing to be paid by the hour for work actually performed as Justice of the Peace," Santini declared. He said the Clark County Board of Commissioners is now considering a salary schedule for the office and he was suggesting a method insuring full return for the money taxpayers are assessed to pay justice court operating costs.

"I would be willing to let my salary be determined by the number of hours I work as the Justice of the Peace," he declared. "If I am not in the courthouse in justice of the peace duties, I should not be paid."

He suggested that since the municipal judges of Las Vegas are presently paid \$19,500 a year, "I believe an equivalent salary would be fair for the Justice of the Peace, who has the responsibility for small claims court traffic sessions and the felony preliminary hearing burden." He said that if the justice of the peace's salary is set at \$10 an hour for a 40-hour-week, this would mean an annual salary of approximately \$20,000 a year, but if he didn't work those hours, under Santini's proposal, he wouldn't be paid that amount.
