## Stover For Constable

MARSHALL L. "SMOKEY" STOVER was born in Ardmore, Oklahoma, but lived most of his early school years in Oklahoma City. His family later moved to Manhattan, Kansas so that Stover and his brother could attend Kansas State College which was traditional in the family, their greatgrandfather having been one of its original founders.

Stover attended college for three years when World War II interrupted his education. He enlisted in the Army and after completing basic training he was sent to the Military Intelligence Language school at Yale University. After doing military service in China, he was honorably discharged and in 1946 he returned to Kansas State College and obtained a B. A. degree in Education with a minor in Industrial Arts.

Envolvement in community affairs comes naturally to Stover. His family, Quaker pioneers to the midwest, have been for many generations prominent in education, law, newspaper publishing and politics. His grandfather served as Lieutenant Governor of Kansas and his Grandmother holds the unique distinction of being the first woman to have ever been elected to the office of Mayor in the U.S. and she served in that capacity for two years in 1885-6 at Argonia, Kansas. Stover's uncle served as Assistant United States District Attorney in Oklahoma (See Stover page 12)
