## Gunderson Seeks Nevada Supreme Court Bench

In a joint statement issued today, a group of prominent Lyon County Democrats and Republicans announced the formation of "Lyon County Citizens for Gunderson," a non-partisan organization formed to support the candidacy of E. M. "Al" Gunderson, candidate for the Supreme Court of Nevada.
