Charges Top G.O.P. Out To Brainwash Voters Senator Howard Cannon lashed out Saturday

If the administration gets away with this massive power play it will be a sad day for our state and our country.

Urban Developement. Vice President Spiro Agnew topped the Romney act to be followed in turn by Treasury Secretary David Kennedy, U. N. Ambassador Shirley Temple Black, Congressional Campaigh Chairman John Tower. "Now we understand Secretary of the Interior

Walter Hickle is on his way to Nevada and he will be followed by Robert Finch, erstwhile Secretary of Health Education and Welfare now turned presidential assistant.

"Waiting in the wings," Cannon said, "are Mrs. Pat Nixon and even the President himself whose visits to beleagured Nevada voters are promised in the next week before election day. When he arrives," the senator said, "I suggest he visits the unemployment offices here. That is where he will find the biggest crowds in town these days.
