The Housing Authority of the City of Las Vegas, has initiated the construction of the Addeliar D. Guy Youth Center. The project, located on Highland Drive, between Washington and McWilliams Streets, will consist of, two regulation size, lighted basketball and tennis courts and will include a pony league baseball field.

The building was designed to maximize the concept of multi-purpose and simultaneous use. It will contain a complete photographic laboratory, an extensive arts and crafts lab, a communication center and a library with emphasis on ethnic studies.

The structure will include a portable stage permitting dramatic productions, youth dances special entertainment activities and meetings. According to the Authority's Community Rel-

According to the Authority's Community Relations Director, Art Chapman, the facility is by no means a stop gap measure, but it is a positive step toward meeting the needs of the community's, youth in the vital areas of rehabilitation and self development.

The project designed by, Zick & Sharp Architects, is being built by, Coronado Construction of Henderson, Nevada at a construction price of \$280,000.00, with completion scheduled for May 20, 1971.

Chapman, who will be director of the center, with the assistance of recreation aides supplied by the City of Las Vegas, stated that, the facility will not be limited to one segment of the community, but that a policy of open participation will be maintained.
