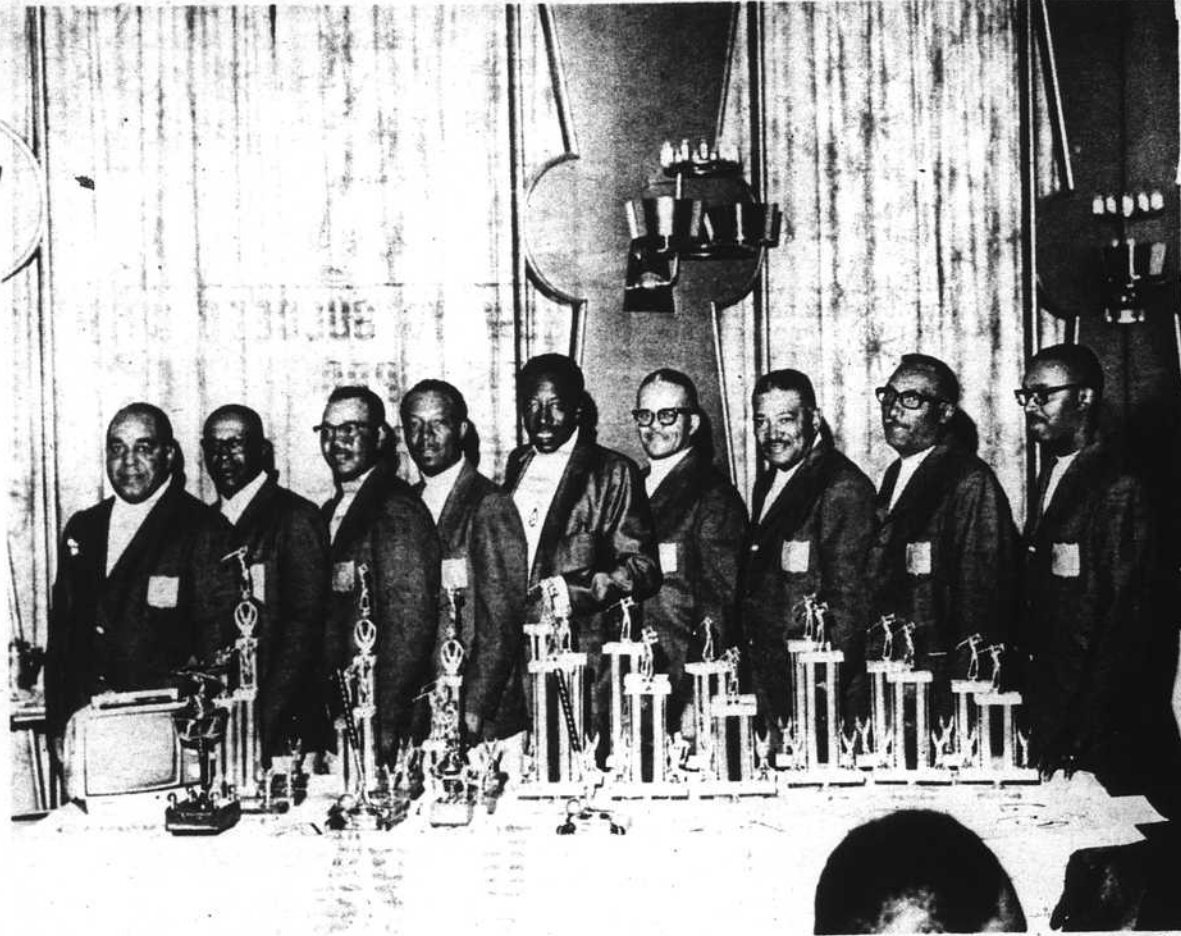


THE SEEN AT THE SCENE

"We hope we can expand it," he concluded. Also due in January is a report to the Board of School Trustees on the most feasible way of extending lunch service to all students attending Clark County School District schools. Preliminary indications are that the program may involve either District-owned and operated central kitchens, or a catering arrangement with an institutional foods contractor.

A possibility also exists that the addition of assembly line equipment to existing kitchens might allow the school district to provide lunches to all students.

Greer told the committee that free and reduced price lunches are available to needy students in any school where lunches are served. He said students being bussed to achieve integration qualify for lunch service, either paid or free as appropriate. Other students in integration school can have a free meal, but meals are not available for purchase except by students being bussed in the integration program.
