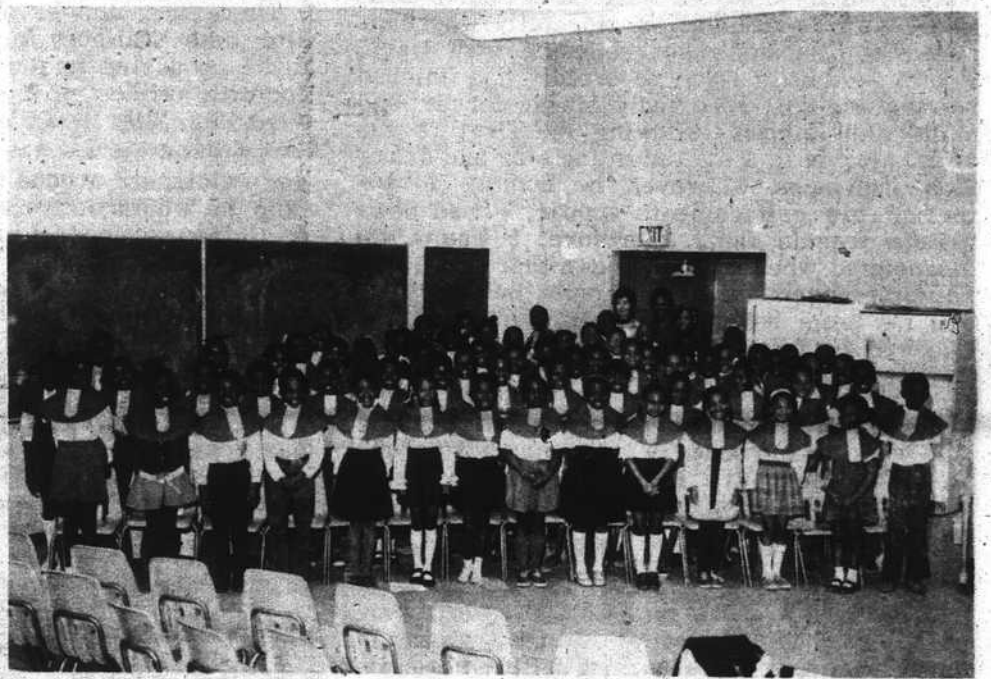

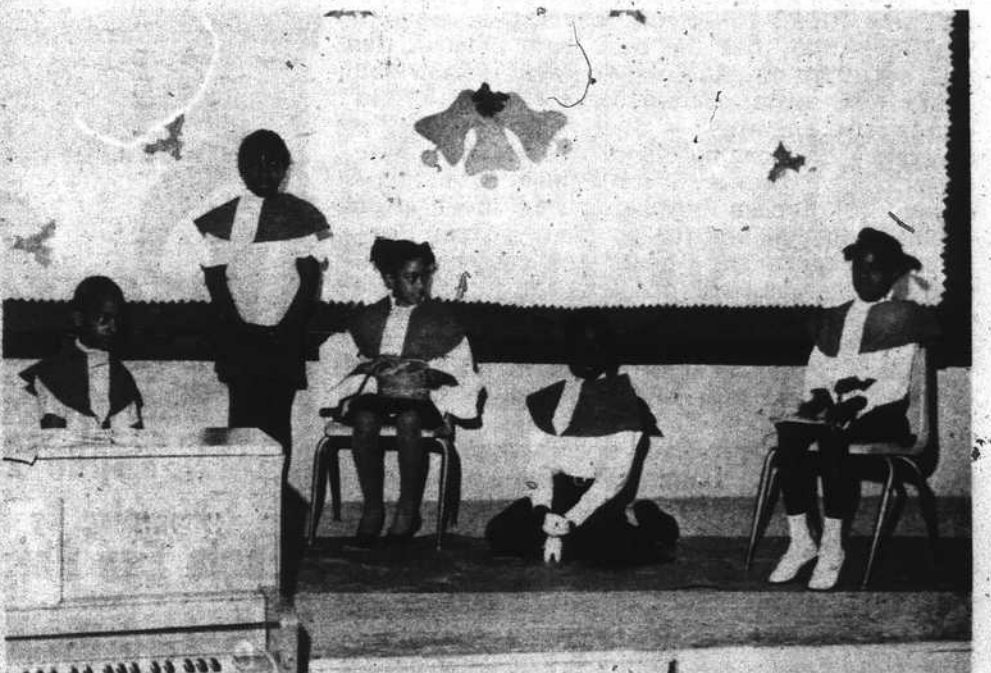
The Christmas program at Jo Mackey Elementary School was presented by the Fourth Grade Department.
