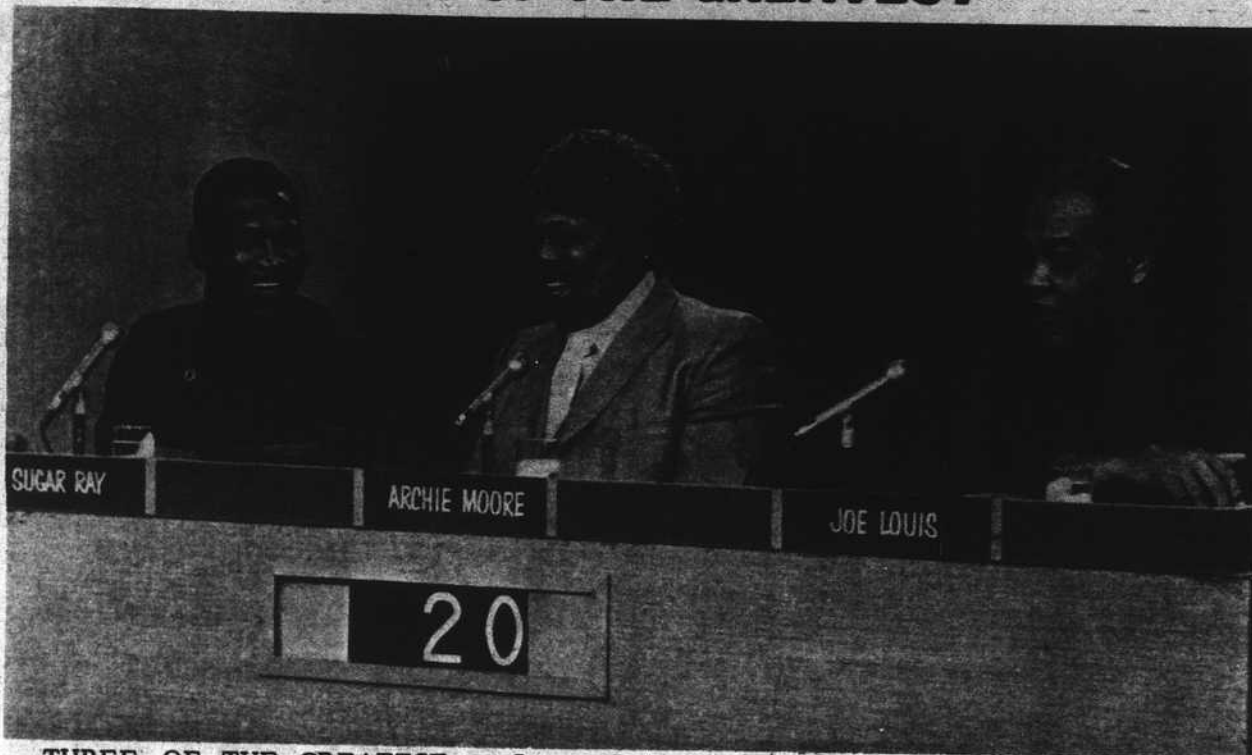


THREE OF THE GREATEST

GIVE A RIGHT TO 18 YEAR OLDS TO VOTE

The Las Vegas Branch of the National Association for the Advancement of Colored People strongly urge Gov. Mike O'Callaghan and the Nevada State Legislature to vote for and place on the June 8, 1971 ballot a proposition giving the citizens of the State of Nevada the opportunity to vote on whether 18 year olds should have the right to vote in state elections.

The NAACP has fought Nation-Wide for many years to give the 18 year olds the right to vote, because they are American citizens and should have the experience of participatory Democracy just like every one else according to Jesse D. Scott, Executive Director, of the branch.

Scott further states that young people should be given a full chance to share in the opportunities and responsibilities of this government. All of the evidence points to the fact that young people are just as aware, concerned, and rational as older people. Age has no corners of understanding and wisdom. Scott believes that it will cost the State of Nevada a lot of money, headaches and trouble for Office of the Registrar of Voters if dual elections are held in November, 1972.
