Kindergarden Students Need Birth Certificates

Students entering kindergarden this fall and first graders not previously enrolled here must have a birth certificate or other proof of age at the time of registration, according to Theron Swainston, Assistant Superintendent for Elementary Education.

Proof of age will not be required of first grade students now attending kindergarden in the Clark County School District.

Nevada law says that kindergarden children must be five years old by December 31, and first graders must be six by the same date. Senate Bill 77, pending in Carson City, would move those dates up to November 30 next year, October 30 the following year, and finally to September 31 the third year.

Birth certificates for children born in Clark County since 1955 can be secured at the Clark County Health Department, 625 Shadow Lane, Las Vegas. The fee is \$2.00.

Children born in other states will have certificates in the Bureau of Vital Statistics in that state's capitol.
