cautiously and only as business activity shows tangible improvement," Archie noted. He added job openings statewide are at a minimum and reflect national economic conditions.

As tourist trade heightens, entry level job-seekers will be hired. But currently, Archie said, only experienced workers are being hired for the few jobs available.

Budget cuts last month at the Nevada Test Site knocked 300 persons off payrolls. Further reductions are expected in the next few months with more slashes in federal spending for nuclear testing.

Nevada mining activity, earlier slowed with closures in silver and gold mines, suffered another setback in March, with more than 60 miners laid off in the state's copper industry.

HAL MORELLI COMMISSIONER CANDIDATE

Hal Morelli, a Las Vegas resident for 22 years and well-known radio and television personality, is hard at work campaigning for the post of City Commissioner No 1. He has taken a leave of absence from his broadcast duties in order to meet the people in person.

Morelli reveals that in his race to the wire on Tuesday, he has been asked many times why he is running for office.

I will be most active in enlarging the scope of such stimulation for Las Vegas' future," Morelli promised. He also indicated that his involvement in the political structure also includes opening up



every channel of communication with experts in the drug and narcotics field, not only in Nevada, but in various key cities where preventive and educational programs are in operation.

Morelli is 46. A member of the U. S. Marine Corps, with three years of service in the South Pacific, he later enrolled in UCLA for studies
