Q. I work for a company that has an excellent pension plan. Why must I also contribute to social security?

A. Unfortunately not all workers are covered by private pension plans, and many workers don't stay with the same employer long enough to qualify for the company pension. You must contribute to social security—and your employer must match your contribution—to ensure that there are enough funds to provide benefits to the largest number of people at the lowest cost to them and their employers.

Social security does not discourage private retirement plans. Rather, it was envisioned as a base to which additional protection under private plans could be added.

According to Social Security Administration studies, 34 percent of the total income of Americans 65 and older comes from social security benefits. Private group pensions account for 5 percent. Earnings and income from assets provide most of the remainder.

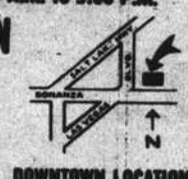
