Voter Registration

County area-wide voter registration will close Saturday, May 1st, for the June 8th Municipal General election, and the Special Election. This announcement by Tom Mulroy, Registrar of Voters, was issued to alert all electors who have not previously registered or who failed to vote in last November's election, to become registered by May 1st.

For the convenience of the public the Election Department will be open daily Tuesday through Saturday, 9 a. m. to 5 p. m. and also in the evening 7 p. m. to 9 p. m.

In addition to the Registrar's office, daily registration (except Saturday, May 1st) will be available at the office of each City Clerk, in Boulder City, Henderson, Las Vegas and North Las Vegas. The Registrar's office is now located at 400 Las Vegas Boulevard South, just south of the Federal Building.

Voters throughout the state will go to the polls on June 8th to vote on a Constitutional Amendment Question to lower the voting age from 21 years to 18 years.
