

Charles J. Perri Seeks Commission Seat No. 1

Charles J. Perri a 23 year resident and recently retired Fire Captain of Las Vegas Fire Department has filed for City Commissioner Seat #1.

His life in the City of Las Vegas in addition to his work in the Las Vegas Fire Department has been devoted to civic and charitable activities.

Perri has been associated with Muscular Dystrophy since 1958 and has been President of the Clark County Chapter of Muscular Dystrophy Association of America Inc. for the past three years and is still active in the Clark County Chapter.

Perri is a member of the Nevada Heart Fund Board of Directors. Perri is a World War II veteran and a member of the American Legion, Disabled American Veterans, Veteran of Foreign Wars, Knights of Columbus, Chairman of the House Committee of the Italian American Club, Past President of the Firefighters local 1285 and Past President of the Catholic Youth Organization of Our Lady of Las Vegas Parish, a member of the Clark County Central Committee.

Perri has devoted his time to the youth of Las Vegas by coaching Pee Wee baseball for 17 years, and while running for City Commissioner he has still found time to coach his baseball team.

Perri has coached Pee Wee Soccer for 9 years, Basketball for 5 years, and Football for 4 years.

Perri says if elected he will fight for additional baseball fields, and parks which are needed. According to a newspaper report last year that only 2700 youngsters played baseball out of a possible 75,000. This is a small percentage of youngsters who would like to play ball because of the baseball fields. Perri is not just making sounds to get the votes from the fathers and mothers who want to get their children interested in wholesome sports because Perri for the past 17 years has been practicing what he preaches.

Perri believes that all School playgrounds be opened after school hours and during the summer

vacations so our children can have a safe place to play. And during school time the gymnasiums be opened to 9:00 p. m. every evening, and they can be supervised by students from UNLV, who are taking a Physical Education course at a nominal wage.

Perri will fight for more parks and parking spaces for these parks which are needed. Las Vegas is in need of more parks for picnics, right now we have Tule Springs, Lions Park, Hadland Park and Hyde Park that are used for picnics. We have other parks but they are not equipped.

All of the candidates are talking recreation, but what have any of them? Events of the past forecast their actions in the future.

Perri is for the Senior Citizens of Las Vegas and he will fight for a recreational area and a meeting room for them, also for cancelling of the City Sales Tax on all Prescription Drugs. Senior Citizens should ride the buses free of charge.

Perri believes that the Water District area should be made into a bridal path and for bicycling and this would at least beautify the area.

Perri is for the beautification of the City of Las Vegas. That all empty lots be cleaned up by the City of Las Vegas free of charge as they are all taxpayers. This will create more jobs for those who are unemployed. A clean city will make life more enjoyable.

Perri feels that local government be returned to and for the people, it has been in the hands of people looking and ruling only for their interests and benefits.

Perri will be a truly full time commissioner whose only interest will be the City of Las Vegas and all its citizens--not those who have contributed handy to their campaigns so they can afford expensive Bill Boards and Radio and Television Advertising.

Q. I will be 65 in April. I have always been a homemaker and I have never been employed. My son tells me I should apply for Medicare. Can I get Medicare?

A. Yes. You should apply for Medicare 3 months before you are 65. Since you have never worked under social security yourself, you will not be eligible for the hospital part of Medicare unless your husband qualifies for social security or railroad retirement benefits. But, you can sign up for the medical insurance part of Medicare even if you cannot get hospital insurance protection.
