News from the Capitol

WASHINGTON--Nevada Senator Howard Can-non today introduced legislation designed to significantly boost the spending power of America's senior citizens.

Essentially, the measure would increase the amount of earnings a social security recipient could receive before reduction of benefits.

Cannon proposed to exempt \$208 each month from benefit reduction. The present exemption is \$140. "Our retired citizens, perhaps more than others, are suffering from the pains of inflation and recession," Cannon said in a

Senate floor speech.

He said his bill would ease the economic crisis for retired people and encourage many talented retirees to seek work that would supplement their pension income.

Cannon also introduced a measure to amend the social security act to provide a \$100 floor for the monthly insurance benefit payment. The present minimum is \$70.40. A similar measure died in the waning days of the last Congress.

"These measures are rock bottom steps which must be taken to help offset the increases in the cost of living that have occurred during the past year," the senator d_manded.
