THAT UBIQUITOUS DRESS CODE

Hot pants (we'll define those a little later) are out for girls this fall in school of the Clark County School District, and so are a few other costumes that tend to detract from the learning environment, according to secondary principals.

But very few restrictions are placed on dress this year; it's pretty much up to you. Some forbidden apparel should be obvious:

braless girls in muscle shirts will be sent home and so will boys who want to go topless. Ripped-off trousers for boys and girls are also out, and so is the barefoot trend (this last more as a safety and health measure than any abhorrence of bare feet).

Black Children Perpetual Scapegoats

The Clark County School District has done it a gain! C.V.T. Gilbert Elementary Prestige School was not enough, now Jo Mackey Elementary School will become prestige with thousands of dollars being spent on new equipment and remodeling to make it more attractive, WHY? To accommodate less than 200 white children. And to think the school district saw no prior need for physical improvement or equipment when only the 500 Black children were at Jo Mackey. Not only that, but now the Black male principal of the school who was qualified to handle Black children, will now have a white woman director to see that he treats the white children with lots of understanding care.

NOW, LET'S SEE! ANOTHER PRESTIGE SCHOOL FOR WHAT?

1. To integrate a few middle class white children in a Black school that will emphasize whites

2. To continue segregation in an integrated (supposedly) situation. Children are grouped by test scores and reading level resulting in all Black or White groups maybe with several Whites or Blacks integrated (?) within the group.

3. To continue comparison of Blacks against whites instead of individual ability.

4. Black children treated with indifference, impatience and given little individual assistance by insensitive white teachers who cannot cope with Black children.

5. For Dr. Edna Hinman to take more control of the Black Community; she will be Director of two Black schools and a Teacher Corps Program designed to work with Black children.

What kind of integration is this? Voluntary-integration means you enroll your children in the school of your choice! Keep them in the Black schools. Don't bus your children, until you know all the facts. Fill the Prestige Schools with Black children and keep the Administration Black.

We don't need another Prestige School like Gilbert.

Birth Certificates

Children entering kindergarten for the coming school year, and first graders who have not previously attended school in Clark County, will be required to present birth certificates or other proof of date of birth.

Birth certificates for children born in Clark County from 1955 to the present can be secured at the Clark County Health Department, 625 Shadow Lane, Las Vegas. The fee is \$2.00.

Birth certificates for children born in Clark

County before 1955, and those born in all other Nevada counties, can be secured at the Department of Health and Welfare, Division of Health, Section of Vital Statistics, Carson City, Nevada. The fee is \$2.00.

Children born in other states should apply for birth certificates from the Bureau of Vital Statistics in the state capitol.

Children must be five years old by November 30, 1971, to enter kindergarten and six years old by December 31, 1971 to enter first grade.
