SENATOR BIBLE SPONSORS BILL TO AID VIETNAM VETS

WASHINGTON--Senator Alan Bible, D-Nev., has sponsored legislation to provide supplemental unemployment compensation benefits to recently discharged Vietnam veterans.

Under the bill, veterans could receive \$75 per week for up to 52 weeks while unemployed.

Bible said that at the end of the first quarter of 1971, there were more than 370,000 Vietnam era unemployed veterans nationwide. This re-

presented 10.8 percent of the national employ-ment total and a 12 percent unemployment rate. "Because of the tightest job market in years, veterans' readjustment problems are worse than they might ordinarily be, "Bible said, "and these supplemental benefits should help ease the pain of the transition."

dated version of the old GI Bill payment plan. Under this proposal, Vietnam veterans attending school would be eligible for a monthly allowance of \$175 with a sliding scale based on the current assistance plan for veterans with

dependants. The bill would also authorize the Veterans Administration to pay up to \$1,000 per school year to any approved educational or training

institution on behalf of a qualifying veteran. "By encouraging returning servicemen to continue their education we not only help them build productive futures, we are providing our nation with the trained personnel to meet the challenges of the next decade, "Bible said.




