E.O.B. Clinic IF YOU MISS YOUR VOICE, **Emphasizes Importance** Of Immunization

"Don't take a chance with your child's health" is the urgent message to parents from Linda Totty, Health Services Supervisor for the Economic Opportunity Board of Clark County's Health Clinic

Immunization shots are free to your child at 940-A West Owens in the East Mall of the Golden West Shopping Center. These shots are given by the Public Health nurse on Tuesday, Wednesday, and Thursday of each week at 2:30 to 4:30 p.m. Immunization shots protect your childfromDiptheria, Tetanus (Lockjaw), Whooping Cough, Measles, and Polio.

To protect children from these diseases and, also, to protect the community from an epidemic, every child should receive these shots beginning from age two (2) months or anytime, thereafter.

Whenever large numbers of people are living close to each other who have not been immunized, there is always the danger of an epidemic striking that community. It is for this reason the Nevada State Legislature passed a law requiring children entering school for the first time to receive their immunization shots.

If transportation to the Clinic is a problem, the Economic Opportunity Board will provide it. Just call the E.O.B. Health Clinic at 648-3280, Ext. 68 or 89.
