DIGGS RIGHT; FOUGHT NIXON'S ANTI-BLACK DOLLARS FOR PORTUGAL

The verbal attack upon Congressman Charles Diggs by George Bush, chief U.S. delegate to the United Nations, and by Congressman Edward J. Derwinski, Illinois Republican serving as a U.S. delegate to the United Nations, shows how wide the gulf is between "establishment" conservatives and black leaders.

Bush and Derwinski said Diggs' strong disagreement with the United States policies toward Africa were merely political.

The conservatives, represented by Bush and Derwinski, evidently are attuned to the bankrupt fiction that the game of life can be played correctly with two different sets of rules—one set with premiums for whites and another set with penalties for blacks.

The attack by Bush and Derwinski came when Diggs resigned from the U.S. delegation to the United Nations. Diggs was protesting the agreement President Nixon made to supply nearly one-half billion dollars worth of "economic credits" to Portugal in exchange for continued use of military bases on the Azores.

The Detroit Congressman, often regarded as moderate by other black leaders, called a press conference to announce his resignation and there denounced the Nixon administration's policies as "an open alliance with Portugal" which, he said, would use the credits to purchase more war planes, napalm and bombs to hurl upon black people seeking freedom and independence in the African territories of Portugese Guinea, Angola and Mozambique.

OTHER CHARGES

Diggs leveled three additional charges at United States policy toward Africa. They are:

1. That the United States has relaxed its arms embargoes to permit Portugal to buy light planes and helicopters it needs to attack African blacks.
 2. That the United States, beginning in 1969, began dodging important U.N. questions on black African freedom and now has begun to vote for European imperialists seeking to suppress black freedom fighters.
 3. That the Nixon administration refused to oppose seriously the 1971 Military Procurement Act amendment which provided for the purchase of chrome from Rhodesia—a purchase that violated the United Nations embargo against the white-supremacy government. Nixon signed the violation in November.
- Diggs said present U. S. policy amounts to "partnership in the subjugation of the African people." The United States, he said, is giving money to Portugal to "wage war against the

black peoples" of Africa in spite of Diggs' strong protests.

BLACKS WINNING

Black freedom fighters on Portugese Guinea on the coast of West Africa have gained control of more than one-half the country. They are led by Amilcar Cabral, a tough, black, 48-year-old agronomist who has been fighting for 15 years and who has five thousand men. The Portugese army, needing financial aid, has twenty-five thousand men trying to defeat the Africans.

Thirty-three African states have attained independence since 1956, but Portugal has indicted it intends to keep controlling millions of blacks with several hundred thousand whites. And it intends to continue reaping millions of dollars from natural resources taken by force from the homeland of African blacks.

Congressman Diggs, a student of African affairs, certainly should have resigned to call attention to the administration's anti-black position and to indicate his opposition.

Let us urge Congressman Diggs and other leaders, of all races, to keep a journal of the administration's unsavory deeds and explain these deeds and their consequences to the enlightened voters in the 1972 Presidential election.
