

EOB Opens Community Alcholism Center In WLV



"Open House" festivites, (Friday), marked the opening of the second Community Alcholism Center to become operative, locally, under an OEO-funded Alcholism Program, delegated by the Economic Opportunity Board of Clark County to the State Alcholism Program for administration under the direction of Earl Pomerleau, Coordinator of the Nevada Alcholism Division (Southern Office). The newest facility is located at 330 West Washington Blvd Friday "Open House" will provide opportunity for West Las Vegas residents, a sprinkling of public officials, representatives from a number of social agencies, and members of the working press to be made coversant with the services the Center will offer as delineated by the Center's Alcoholism Counselor, Mrs. Louise Roberston.

Mrs. Robertson noted that the need for a Community Alchololism Center in West Las Vegas had become increasingly apparent when it was realized that other Centers established over the past two years were not reaching the Black population of the Las Vegas area. She said that services of the Center will include, along with counseling of the Alcholic and his (or her) families, information and educational programs on alcoholism, referral services, and the establishment of community "contact groups.

Mrs. Robertson brings a weath of knowledge, experience, and an obvious commitment to the rehabilitation of alcoholics to the position of Alcoholism Counselor.
