since September of last year. In May, 1971, the District Attorney's office, with Stanton Colton as administrative coordinator, surveyed 20% of the students in sophomore, junior and senior grades

Purpose of the survey was to determine major problems contributing to the communication gap between that age group and adults of the community. It was found that 68% of participating students felt that police and parental relations are the two major contributors to the communications problem. A close third were drugs and narcotics. Other concerns were school pressures and war-related uncertainties.

There were 10 proposed corrective measures incorporated in the survey. More commercial recreation facilities for youth received a 78% endorsement, followed closely by improving the teenage image. Revision in some laws and more responsibilities for youth were also included as effective means of correcting the gap.

Woofter explained that the purpose of the conference is to discuss these and other issues and set up corrective measures. "There will be action projects developed involving both the teenage and adult segments of the community," Woofter said. "The desired result will be a better understanding by the adult and youth segments of the community, instilling a greater respect for the law and, hopefully, eliminating the communications gap in favor of cooperative bridging."
