Also the Federal share of manpower costs will increase from 80 to 90 percent.

Although the new regulations become effective July 1, persons have 30 days to submit suggested revisions.

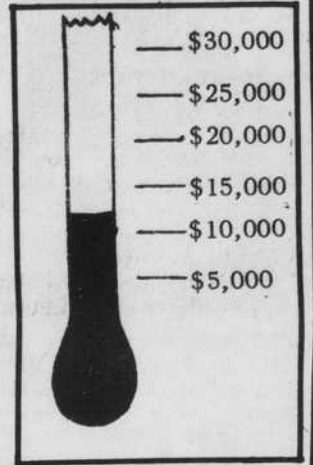
