Bernice Moten Files For School Trustee



Mrs. Bernice Moten, a 13-year Clark County educator, has filed for the Board of School Trustees from District C, which covers the northwest area of Las Vegas and western sec-

tions of North Las Vegas.

Mrs. Moten, who is employed as the equal education consultant to the Nevada State Department of Education, has a broad background in teaching, administration, curriculm and human relations. Prior to her State position, the candidate spent 10 years as a Clark County classroom teacher, including all levels-elementary through high school and two years part-time teaching at UNLV. She has been a consultant in minority education to the Clark County School District, as well as to education departments in other states, and has served on several District task forces, including those on school integration and curriculm revision.

Mrs. Moten believes that the School Board's primary responsibility is to provide each child with an equal opportunity to acquire the skills necessary to adult life in their chosen career. If elected she pledged to work for "a lower pupil-teacher ratio, model school standards applied to all schools, not just to a chosen few, and curriculm which meets each child at his level of need and helps him get where he wants

to go."
The candidate is also concerned about the lack of facilities in her school area. "In the entire District C" Mrs. Moten pointed out "there are no high schools and only one junior high school; and all but one of the elementary schools closed by school authorities are in her district." One of the problems, according to the educator, is "the lack of communication (see MOTEN, page 6)


